Moreover, I expect you to be involved in research with me on several ongoing projects examining Chinese international students' experience in the U.S. and pursuing understanding of the role of culture in psychological health. Both the U.S. Department of State and the University of Kansas require J-1 Exchange Visitors to have medical insurance during their entire stay in the United States.
